11	abortion:			
12	<u>a.</u>	Immediately prior to administering the drug Mifepristone, the physician		
13		or qualified health professional shall inform the woman that (i) it is still		
14		possible to discontinue a drug-induced abortion by not taking the		
15		prescribed Misoprostol and taking progesterone to reverse the effects of		
16		the Mifepristone and (ii) information on how, where, and from whom		
17		women can obtain assistance in discontinuing a drug-induced abortion is		
18		available on the Department of Health and Human Services' Internet		
19	_	Web site.		
20	<u>b.</u>	Immediately prior to administering the drug Misoprostol, the physician		
21		or qualified professional shall provide medical proof to the woman that
