6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-7 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
7	"(q2) <u>Deaf o</u>	or Hard of Hearing Designation The Division shall develop, in consultation
8	with the Department of Public Safety, the State Highway Patrol, the Division of Services for	
9	the Deaf and Har	d of Hearing, and pursuant to this subsection, a drivers license designation that
10		st, be granted to a person who is deaf or hard of hearing. The Division shall
11	comply with the	following requirements applicable to the designation:
12	<u>(1)</u>	At the request of a person who is deaf or hard of hearing, the Division shall
13		place a unique symbol on the front of the person's license. The unique
14		symbol placed on the license shall not include any further descriptor. The
15		Division shall record the designation in the electronic record associated with
16		the person's drivers license.
17	<u>(2)</u>	At the request of a person who is deaf or hard of hearing, the Division shall
18		enter the drivers license symbol and a descriptor into the electronic record of
19		any motor vehicle registered in the same name of the deaf or hard of hearing
20		person.
21	<u>(3)</u>	Medical certification or examination is not required to make a request
22		pursuant to this subsection.
23	<u>(4)</u>	Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as authorizing the issuance of a
24		drivers license to a person ineligible under G.S. 20-9.
25	<u>(5)</u>	Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as prohibiting the issuance of a
26		<u>drivers license to a person otherwise eligible under the law.</u>
27	<u>(6)</u>	Any individual who chooses to register or not to register shall not be deemed
28	 ->	to have waived any protections under the law.
29	<u>(7)</u>	Information collected under this subsection shall only be available to law
30		enforcement and only for the purpose of ensuring mutually safe interactions
31		between law enforcement and persons who are deaf or hard of hearing. It
32		shall not be accessed or used for any other purpose.
