The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 132-1.4A(h) reads as rewritten:		
"(h) Release of Recordings; Law Enforcement Purposes. – Notwithstanding the requirements of subsections (c), (f), and (g) of this section, a custodial law enforcement agency shall disclose or release a recording to a district attorney (i) for review of potential criminal charges, (ii) in order to comply with discovery requirements in a criminal prosecution, (iii) for use		
in criminal proceedings in district court, or (iv) <u>for</u> any other law enforcement purpose, and <u>may</u> <u>may</u> , in its sole discretion, disclose or release a recording for any of the following purposes:
