A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN COLUMBUS COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The office of coroner in Columbus County is abolished.
SECTION 2. Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to Columbus

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
