5	SECTION 1. G.S. 96-1(b)(12) reads as rewritten:			
6	"(12) Employment. – Defined in section 3306 of the Code, with the following			
7	additions and exclusions:			
8		a.	Addit	tions The term includes service to a governmental unit, a
9			nonpi	rofit organization, or an Indian tribe as described in 3306(c)(7)
10			and 3	306(c)(8) of the Code.
11		b.	Exclu	sions. – The term excludes all of the following:
12			1.	Service performed by an independent contractor.
13			2.	Service performed for a governmental entity or nonprofit
14				organization under 3309(b) and 3309(c) of the Code.
15			3.	Service by one or more of the following individuals if the
16				individual is authorized to exercise independent judgment and
17				control over the performance of the work and is compensated
18				solely by way of commission:
19				A. A real estate broker, as defined in G.S. 93A-2.
20				B. A securities salesman, as defined in G.S. 78A-2.
21			<u>4.</u>	Service performed by a direct seller, as defined in 3508(b)(2)
22				of the Code. The term does not include a person defined in
23				3508(b)(2)(A)(iii) of the Code."
24	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2017, applies to claims for			
25	benefits filed on or after that date, and applies to tax calculations on or after that date.
