2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL REPORT TO THE
3	SUPERINTENDENT ON NONCOMPLIANCE WITH CLASS SIZE REQUIREMENTS
4	IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH THIRD GRADE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-47(10) reads as rewritten:
7	"(10) To Assure Appropriate Class Size. – It shall be the responsibility of local
8	boards of education to assure that the class size requirements set forth in
9	G.S. 115C-301 for kindergarten through third grade are met. Any teacher
10	who believes that the requirements of G.S. 115C-301 have not been met
11	shall make a report to the principal and superintendent, and the
12	superintendent shall immediately determine whether the requirements have
13	in fact not been met. If the superintendent determines the requirements have
14	not been met, he or sheThe principal of each school in the local school
15	administrative unit shall report noncompliance with the class size
16	requirements for kindergarten through third grade as set forth in
17	G.S. 115C-301 to the superintendent on the first school day of each month.
18	The superintendent shall make a report to the local board of education on
19	noncompliance with the class size requirements set forth in G.S. 115C-301
20	at the next local board of education meeting. The local board of education
21	shall take action to meet the requirements of the statute. If the local board
22	cannot organizationally correct the exception, it shall immediately apply to
23	the State Board of Education for additional personnel or a waiver of the class
24 25	size requirements, as provided in G.S. 115C-301(g).
25	Upon notification from the State Board of Education that the reported
26	exception does not qualify for an allotment adjustment or a waiver under exception $c \in C$ 115C 201, the level heard within 20 down whell take
27	provisions of G.S. 115C-301, the local board, within 30 days, shall take
28	action necessary to correct the exception.
29 30	At the end of the second month of each school year, the local board of education through the superintendent, shall file a report with the State Board
30 31	education, through the superintendent, shall file a report with the State Board
31 32	of Education, in a format prescribed by the State Board of Education, describing the organization of each school, the duties of each teacher, and
32 33	the size of each class. As of <u>November 1 and February 1 of each year</u> , local
33 34	boards of education, through the superintendent, shall report all exceptions
34 35	to individual class size maximums that exist at that time.
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1	In addition to assuring that the requirements of G.S. 115C-301 are met,
2	each local board of education shall also have the duty to provide an adequate
3	number of classrooms to meet the requirements of that statute."
4	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
5	the 2017 2018 asheel wear

5 the 2017-2018 school year.
