1	(h) Report. – No later than March 1, 2025, the Division shall submit an initial report on
2	the implementation of this section to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental
3	Operations, the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee, and the Fiscal Research
4	Division and thereafter shall submit an annual report no later than December 1 of each year. The
5	report shall include the following information: use of funds, projects approved, and estimated
6	economic impact."
7	SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Special Economic
8	Development Fund for Rail the sum of one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) in
9	nonrecurring funds.
10	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
